	discussion but divide half the			
	room. Once half pairs and shares			
	(works in groups of two) and			
	comes up with a definition of			
	legal aid. The other half of the			
	room pairs and shares and comes			
	up with a definition of pro bono.			
	Different groups on each side present their definitions.			
	The large group then is asked to			
	identify elements of the			
	definition of legal aid and pro			
	bono that are the same and that			
	are different.			

	This is written on a flip chart		
	paper		
3	Participants are then divided into	20	
	3 groups. Each group is paired		
	with 1-2 of the presenters.

	1) Group 1: Comes up with ways		
	and means pro bono can assist in		
	supplementing legal aid direct		
	client services.		
	2) Group 2: Comes up with ways		
	pro bono education assists in developing the ethical character		
	of persons who then help to		
	support/go into legal aid services		
	support go into regar ara services		
	3) Group 3: Comes up with some		
	of the ways that an over reliance		
	of pro bono can potentially		
	endanger a legal aid system and		
	ways to avoid this from		
	happening		
	The group discusses this and then writes ideas on a flip chart paper		
	and then presents.		
4	Each presenter then gives 1-2	25	
	examples in their personal		
	experience that touches upon the		
	3 thematic group categories		
	above, speaking for 5-7 minutes		
	each.
