9:15am-10:15am  (60 min)	<p>What is CLE? &amp; Educational and Access to Justice (A2J) Goals of CLE</p> <p><i>Session outcome: The session will demonstrate the watermelon/pumpkin seed philosophy which leads to a discussion about lack of access to justice for marginalized and vulnerable persons and the need of CLE. The participants will understand how CLE differs from traditional legal education and be exposed to some types of CLE programs. This session will discuss the 6 goals of CLE targeting students, community, legal profession, academia, education system, and society as a whole, which when combined together helps to strengthen and achieve greater access to justice.</i></p>

10:30am-11:30pm  (60 min)	<p>Strengthen students' knowledge, skills, and value – Strengthen access to justice</p> <p><i>Session outcome: This session links to the focus of Goal #1 (strengthen students' knowledge, skills, and ethical/pro bono value). This session will discuss how various CLE teaching methodologies and programmes help strengthen students' knowledge, skills, and values, and how the development of knowledge, skills, and value help to build persons to achieve access to justice. The participants will appreciate the value of Goal #1 in strengthening access to justice and how it helps to achieve access to justice.</i></p>
11:30pm-12:15pm  (45 min)	<p>Achieving Access to Justice by strengthening community</p> <p><i>Session outcome: This session will demonstrate how one of many types of CLE programmes (street-law) provides supplemental legal services (Goal #2) and strengthen access to justice. The participants will appreciate CLE program as one of the tools to achieve access to justice.</i></p>

The session will include an activity focusing on why we need to achieve GOAL 3 of CLE, which is strengthening of an ethical legal profession.</i></p>
