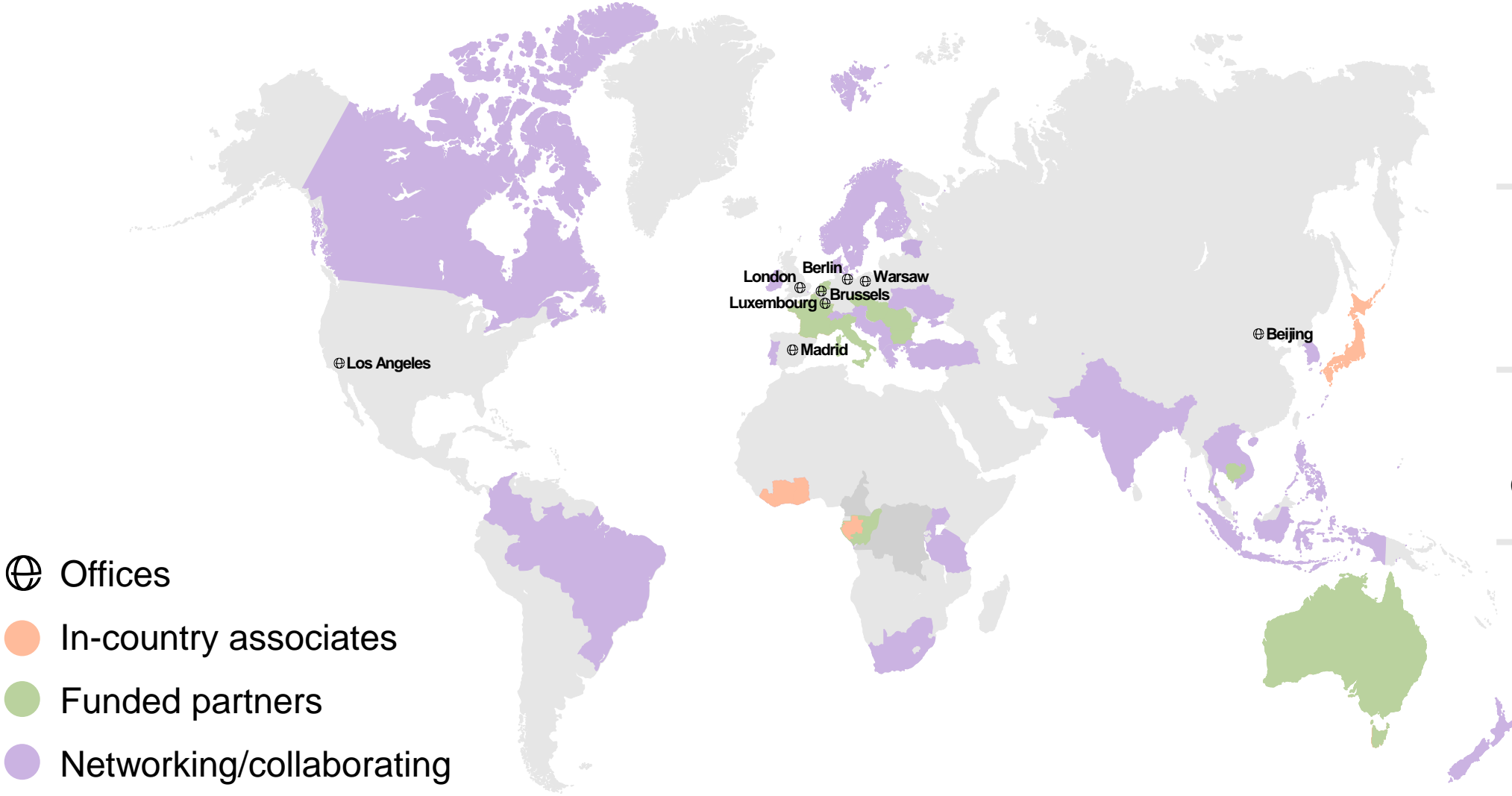

# Case study: Climate Finance

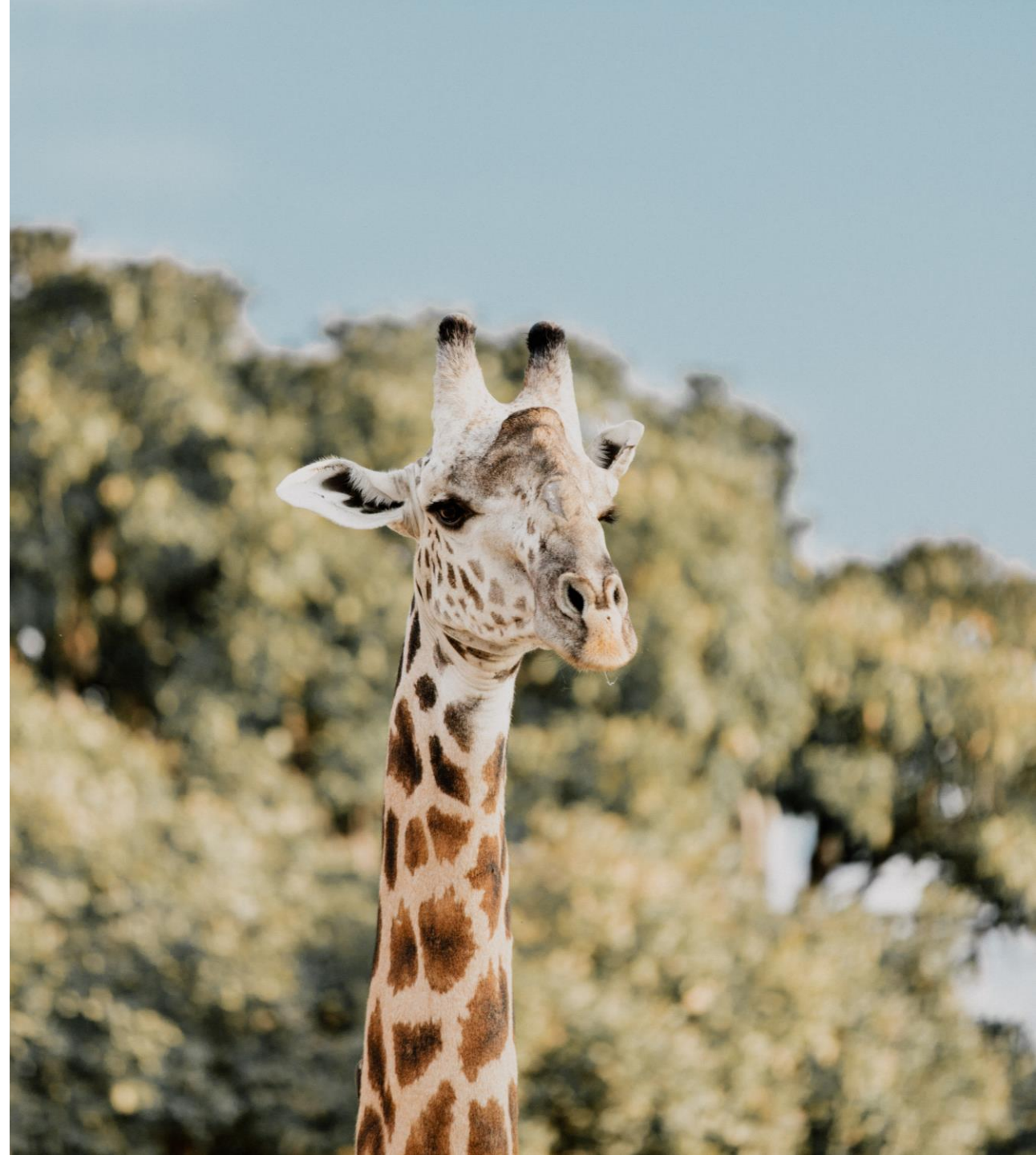
- Novel shareholder challenge to Ostrołęka C power plant

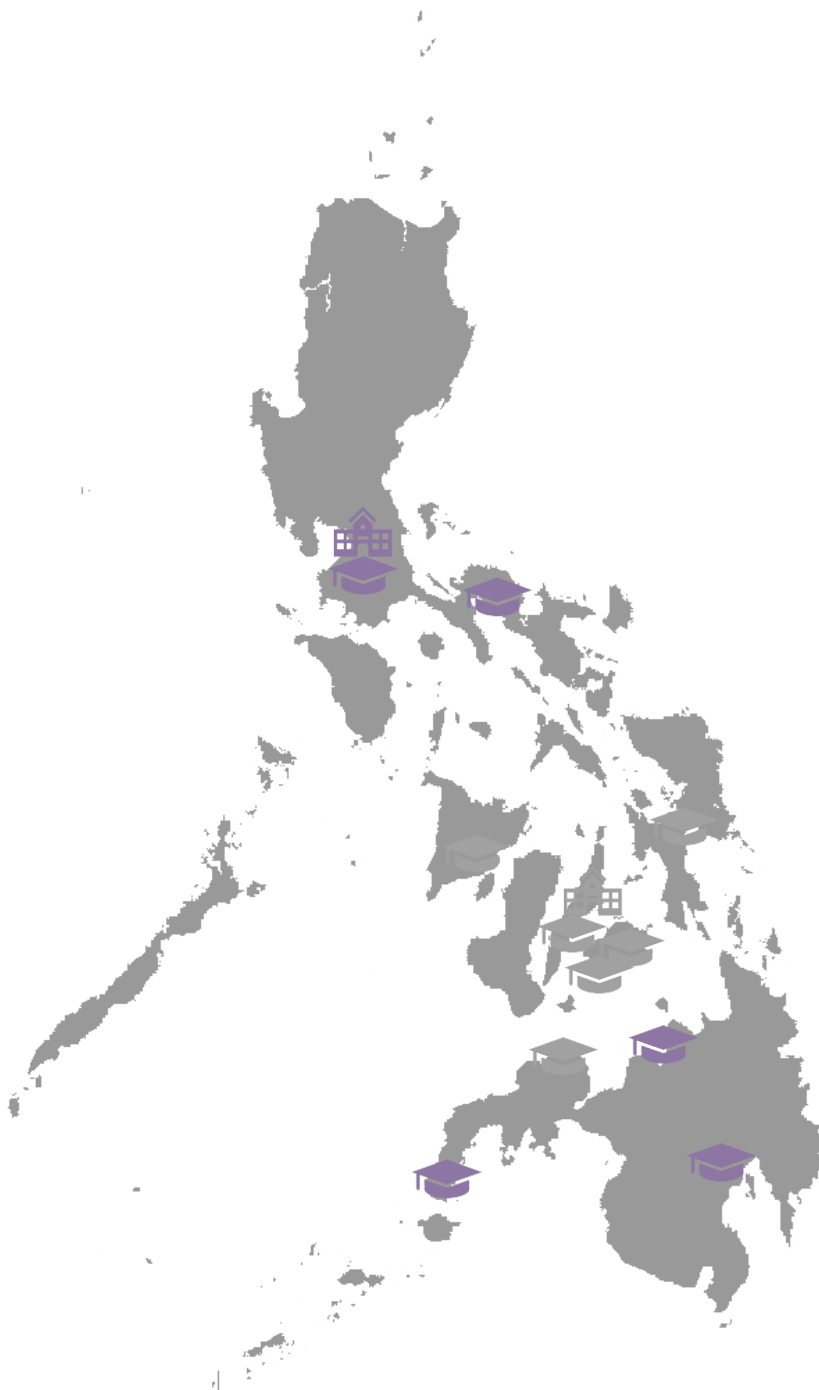
